Scope of practice

Following discussions at the General Business Meeting at the World Confederation for Physical Therapy (WCPT) Congress in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, in 2011, Vice-president Meena Sran is leading a review of the IOPTWH Scope of Practice document, which was first published 7 years ago (IOPTWH 2005). A draft of the revised document has been circulated to the every Chief Delegate so that it can be discussed within each of our member countries. Any changes suggested will be considered by the Executive Committee before the final document is published. Amsterdam women's health networking session
