The portfolio must evidence Physiotherapy experience in one or more of the specialty areas of male and female bladder, bowel and sexual dysfunction and pain; pre and post-natal musculoskeletal dysfunction and pain; breast care, oncology.

The Portfolio is not a descriptive document it must demonstrate skills in CPD including reflective practice, research skills such as reviewing literature and evaluating the impact of clinical practice. It should also reflect enthusiasm and commitment to Pelvic Health Physiotherapy and activities within the POGP.

2. Clinical log book

Descriptor	Candidate attainment	Comments for improvement/ future development.
<p>The candidate has submitted log books of three different patient assessments and three treatment sessions of one of these patients, that have been evaluated by an experienced assessor working in pelvic health. The candidate has been assessed as demonstrating their skills in: subjective history taking of a patient with pelvic health issues, consideration and implementation of professional practice, problem analysis and formulation of a management plan and treatment progression and/ or adaptation. This should all be in line with sound clinical reasoning and awareness of the research evidence available.</p>		
<p>The candidate's submission of log books is insufficient/ incomplete. They have not been sufficiently assessed to be demonstrated the skills outlined above.</p>		

3. Three reflective accounts

These reflections could detail a variety of clinical/ professional/ managerial issues encountered by the candidate.

Descriptor	Candidate assessment	Comments for improvement/ future development.
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<p>The candidate provides three clear, thorough accounts of the issues encountered, how they managed them and how the experience contributed to their professional/ clinical/ managerial development.</p>		
<p>The candidate has not provided three reflective accounts and/ or hasn't provided sufficient detail of the issue that they encountered and how they contributed to their professional/ clinical/ managerial development.</p>		

4.Evidence of attendance at two regional POGP meetings within the last year or involvement in POGP activities (these activities could include: POGP leaflet reviewing/ writing, contributing to website content, POGP journal article reviewing, supporting other sub-committee/ area rep work).

Descriptor	Candidate assessment	Comments for improvement/ future development.
<p>The candidate has provided accounts of two different regional POGP meetings attended and how these meetings contributed to their CPD OR they have provided evidence of two different POGP activities that they have been involved in and how these have contributed to their CPD.</p>		
<p>The candidate has not provided sufficient evidence of attendance a POGP regional meetings or involvement with POGP activities.</p>		



5. Position statement (max 300 words)

Descriptor	Candidate assessment	Comments for improvement/ future development.
The candidate has provided a full position statement detailing the reason for applying for full POGP membership, why the candidate has chosen Pelvic Health as a speciality and the candidate's aspirations for career development/ achievements.
